For Deutsche Morgan Grenfell (DMG) and most of the CSFB IPOs, the executive and the "CSFB Priority" are named in the Excel Attachment to an e-mail (Government Exhibit 2051) dated March 21, 2000 to Frank Quattrone at CSFB. A priority of 1 is high, and a priority of 4 is low, with high priority individuals typically receiving four times as many shares in a given IPO as a low priority investor. (A zero priority probably indicates that the account is just in the process of being set up.) For CSFB IPOs, for the number of IPOs and the Dollar Value of First-day Gains, the information is from the March 7, 2003 *San-Jose Mercury News*. For the Salomon Smith Barney (SSB) IPOs, information is from Citigroup as supplied to the Office of the Attorney General of New York State, released through a Freedom of Information Act request. The dollar value of first-day gains for the 58 SSB executives is computed based on their receipt of 48 IPOs for which we have SSB allocation data. Some common abbreviations used include CEO for Chief Executive Officer, CFO for Chief Financial Officer, COO for Chief Operating Officer, CTO for Chief Technology Officer, and VP for Vice President; n.a. stands for not available for DMG and CSFB IPOs, and not applicable for SSB IPOs. We are inconsistent in listing Director status—most if not all of the Chairmen and CEOs are also Directors, but we don't list the Director status for all. The position of the executive is generally as of the time of the IPO.

We only list the two allocations received from SSB.

## Internet Appendix Table IA-2: First SEOs for DMG, CSFB, and SSB IPOs

This table consists of 54 of the 196 companies in the sample that conducted a seasoned equity offering (SEO) from the time of their IPO to the end of 2001. Only the first SEO in the qualified time period is used for each company. If a company used the same bookrunner for its first SEO as for its IPO, then it is considered to be loyal. Note that for tech companies whose IPOs were underwritten by Deutsche Morgan Grenfell (DMG) from July 1, 1996 to June 30, 1998 and whose first SEOs were underwritten by CSFB from July 1, 1998 to the end of 2001, these companies are designated as loyal (see footnote 2 for an explanation). There are three such cases in our sample. McLeod is classified as not having been spun because the first IPO allocation to CEO Clark McLeod did not occur until September 1997, more than six months after both the IPO and first SEO.
