

IPOs from 1980 – 2018 with Multiple Share Classes Outstanding

Below is a listing of IPOs from 1980 - 2018 including limited partnerships with multiple share classes outstanding. The number of shares listed is the post issue number of shares, computed by adding together all share classes. For example, if a firm issues 1,000,000 class A shares in the IPO and also has 2,500,000 class B shares outstanding, the post-issue number of shares is 3,500,000.
