The City of Gainesville and the Bob Graham Center for Public Service offers UF undergraduates a year-long fellowship within multiple offices in the City of Gainesville. Students will have opportunities to perform project-based work, striving to improve operational city issues, and meet strategic goals.

The focus areas of the fellowship are: Visual Graphic Design, Business Process, Marketing and Media, UX (User Experience) Service Design, Data Visualization, Community Development and Policy Research.

Under the direction of City staff, students who are selected will work part time (15-20 hours per week) during the Fall and Spring semester of the entire academic year. Students will also register for one fellowship credit hours during the fall and spring semesters.

All academic majors are encouraged to apply. Successful candidates are detailed-oriented, self-starters with a passion in improving their communities. A minimum 3.0 GPA is accepted for the fellowship. Preference will be given to students who are in Junior and Senior standing.
